

Submitting an A Project – Submitting your paper

- ✓ Due Thursday, 11 April by 4:30pm to Dr. Shrock's office:

 - ✓ [Click here for the grading rubric](#) where you can see how I will grade your project. I will have hard copies in class, and ask you to place a rubric on the front of your project when you turn it in.
 - ✓ Electronic copy of paper only to Turnitin (*I will not grade your work without it uploaded*)
- ✓ Min. 1200 word 4 page with separate documentation in MLA format ([click here for MLA template](#))
- ✓ Keys to a better grade:
 - ✓ Include 1 quote from text, and reference text repeatedly throughout paper
 - ✓ Do not repeat documentation in paper...this is a separate document. You may reference it
 - ✓ Use MLA format for citing statements and claims and include a separate works cited page
 - ✓ Do not refer to the textbook as in 'our health book', 'in our book', or 'in the text'; refer to the textbook as ...'as cited in Health: the Basics', or 'Donatelle says'...
 - ✓ The title of the textbook is Health: The Basics, **not** the Basics, Health
 - ✓ Utilize learning resource center in Yosemite Hall (second floor) for help with MLA formatting
 - ✓ Put the paper down for one day and re-read it
 - ✓ Have a trusted friend or family member proof read your paper
 - ✓ *Don't procrastinate!*
 - ✓ Any papers turned in late will have 25% deducted from your grade and may not be graded this spring

This paper is worth 1/3rd of your class grade and is meant to be a report on an activity you have completed to improve your health and awareness of how to improve

Submitting your paper to Turnitin

- 1) Log onto your Canvas account, and click on your MHE-110 class ([click here for directions on accessing your Canvas account](#))
- 2) On the HOME page, click on Health Research Project submission link
- 3) Click on submit or assignment box
- 4) Find your name, or type it in
- 5) Type your project title (*not important*)
- 6) Find your project file on your tablet, laptop, or zip-drive and upload (*don't worry on what your paper looks like, I don't grade formatting from this submission*)
- 7) A few moments later you will be given a receipt, and 3-5 min later your originality report
